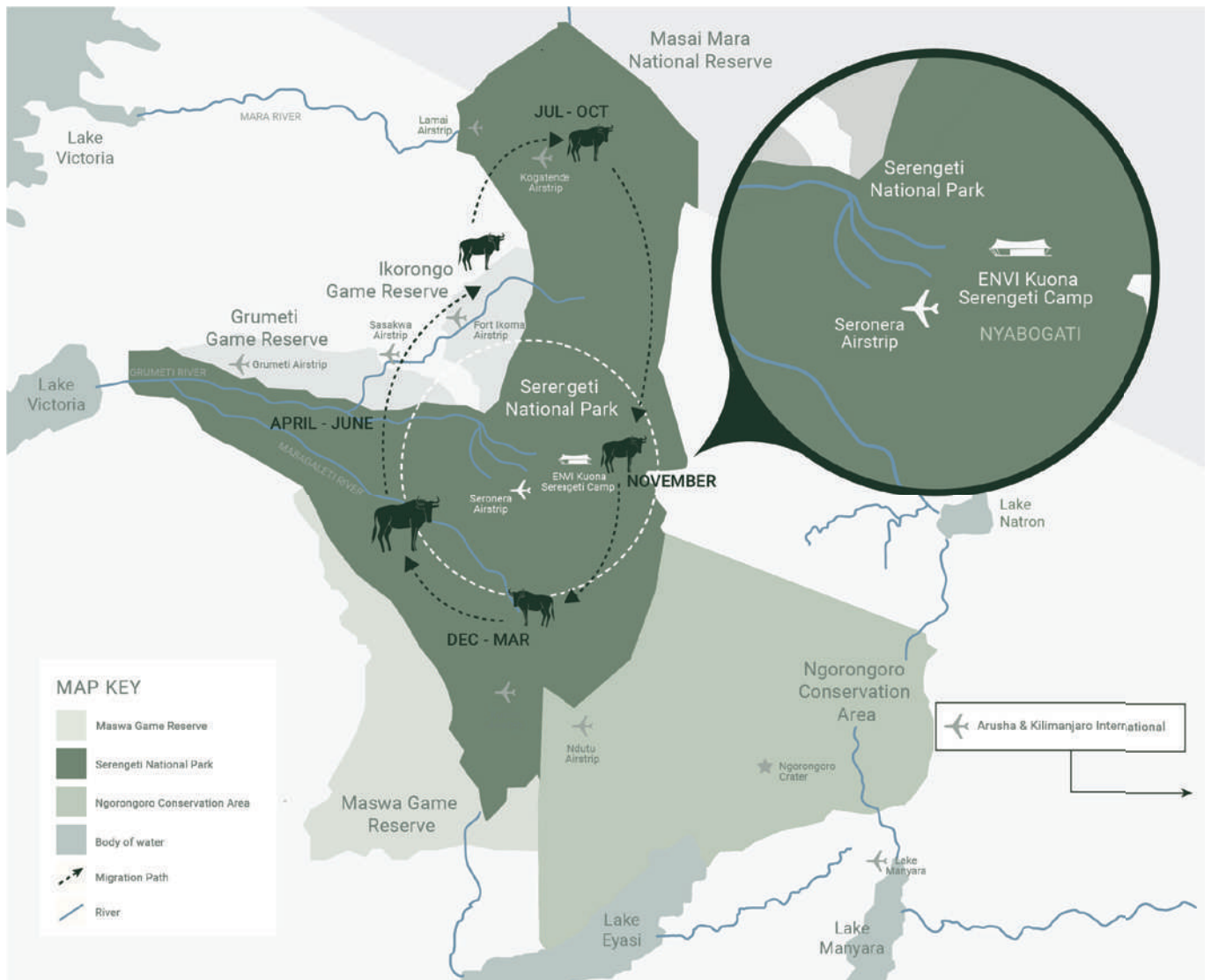

OVERVIEW

Rising from the hilly terrain of the central Serengeti, ENVI Kuona Serengeti is a permanent tented camp designed around visibility: The name “Kuona” means “to see” in Swahili. Sweeping sightlines over the plains, a resident waterhole at its doorstep, and a dedicated photography studio for guests who want to bring the Serengeti home. Open year-round, it is a place to slow down, watch with intention, and indulge in longer stays.



LOCATION AND ACCESS

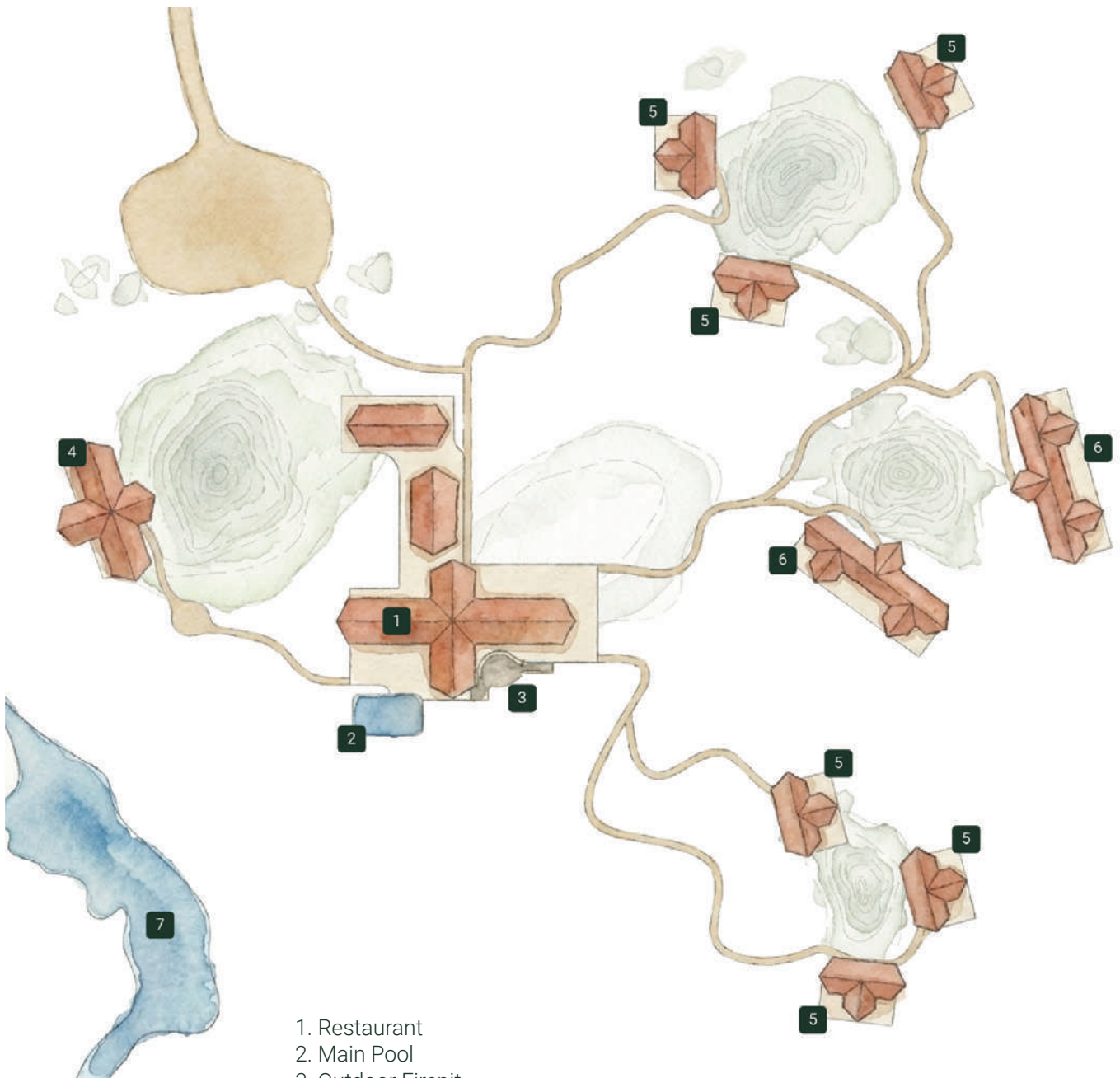
- 📍 Africa | Tanzania | Central Serengeti
- 📍 GPS: 2°24'08.4"S 35°03'45.1"E
- ✈️ Nearest Airstrip: Seronera (SEU)
- 🚗 Transfer: 1h road transfer from Seronera Airstrip to camp, driving in the North East direction
- 🧳 Luggage: Soft canvas bags required on charter flights, max 15 kg (33 lb)

Suggested access: Fly into Julius Nyerere International Airport (DAR) or Kilimanjaro Airport (JRO) and connect via bush charter to Seronera Airstrip (SEU). ENVI's safari vehicles meet guests at the airstrip for a short road transfer to camp.

SEASONS AND WEATHER



THE RHYTHM OF THE SEASONS

JUN – OCT Dry Season

The peak dry season brings the iconic wildebeest migration north. Cool, clear days offer exceptional game viewing and ideal conditions for photography. The central Serengeti sits at the heart of the action.

NOV – DEC Short Rains (Vuli)

Brief afternoon showers transform the plains into lush green. The calving season begins in the south. Fewer visitors and vibrant colours make this a photographer's secret season.

JAN – MAR Calving Season

Warm and mostly dry. The calving season peaks in the southern Serengeti, drawing large predator concentrations. Exceptional wildlife visibility and dramatic skies for photography.

APR – MAY Long Rains (Masika)

The long rainy season brings heavy showers and quieter camps. Verdant landscapes, newborn wildlife, and solitude – a rewarding period for those who seek the Serengeti without the crowds.

NEED TO KNOW

Tanzania Requirements

PASSPORT VALIDITY

Ensure your passport is valid for at least six months beyond your arrival date, with at least one blank page.

VISA REQUIREMENTS

Most visitors require a Tanzania tourist visa. Apply in advance via the official Tanzanian eVisa portal. Visa-on-arrival is no longer guaranteed.

VACCINATIONS & MEDICATIONS

Yellow fever vaccination is required if traveling from or through an endemic country. A valid certificate must be carried. We recommend consulting a travel health clinic prior to departure for Malaria tablets, with special caution for children.

TRAVEL INSURANCE

Comprehensive travel insurance including emergency medical evacuation cover is strongly recommended. Medical facilities in the Serengeti are limited; evacuation to Arusha or Nairobi may be required in emergencies.

LUGGAGE

Soft canvas or duffel bags are required on all charter flights. Maximum 15 kg (33 lb) for checked baggage. Hard-shell suitcases cannot be accommodated.



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
